## WHO WE ARE

*Open Path Mobility Foundation* is a Texas-based nonprofit created to increase access to toddler mobility trainers and related assistive solutions for children and families facing financial barriers.

## OUR RELATIONSHIP WITH MAKEGOOD

We deliver toddler mobility trainers and assistive devices designed by *MakeGood*—an organization known for open-source, user-centered assistive device designs developed in collaboration with people with disabilities. *Open Path Mobility Foundation* serves as a local Central Texas fabrication and delivery partner so families can receive devices faster and with local support. When appropriate, we also design or adapt assistive solutions based on the individual needs of the patient, working collaboratively with families and care teams.

## WHAT WE PROVIDE

- Toddler Mobility Trainers (*MakeGood*-designed) provided to families at no cost (subject to availability and fit).
- Optional protective/cosmetic prosthetic covers (all ages), when appropriate.
- Local fabrication, assembly, and quality checks; coordination with care teams for responsible delivery.

## TYPICAL PROGRAM COSTS

- Toddler Mobility Trainer: ~\$250 average production cost per unit
- Prosthetic cover: ~\$100 average production cost per unit

## HOW WE CAN PARTNER

- Introduce us to social work/care coordination and rehab/PT/OT teams who support children with mobility needs.
- Introductions to families in need of these devices.
- If available, consider community benefit funding, pilot support, or a small program grant to expand local capacity.
